**Opposition to Ballot Measure 2**  
**Change to Election Process**

WHEREAS, Alaska's economy has been seriously damaged by state budget cuts and the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, Alaska depends upon an environment of certainty and predictability to attract investment and grow the economy;

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 2 is allowing outside interests to influence Alaska's election process;

WHEREAS, "Ranked-Choice Voting" is complicated and may disenfranchise voters and is not in the best interest of Alaskan residents;

WHEREAS, 99% of \$3 million in funding for promoting Ballot Measure 1 has been donated from three separate billionaires living outside of Alaska, with no interests in Alaska;

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 2 is a 25-page complex document that should be addressed through the legislative process, not at the ballot box;

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Greater Juneau Chamber of Commerce opposes Ballot Measure 2 and encourages Alaskans to vote NO in November.
